

Subject : **NAMS Awards – Nominations for 2018**

Dear Sir/Madam,

With a view to encourage talent and recognize merit, the National Academy of Medical Sciences (India) has established various Awards.

As per Council decision, the nominations received for Awards will be considered for three consecutive years. In view of this, the candidates who had been nominated in 2016 and 2017 need not send their fresh nominations.

The Council in its meeting held on **30th July, 2014** made the following observations:-

“As decided earlier for the Orations, any bio-medical scientist who is awarded an Oration in a previous year, shall not be considered for the award of another Oration for a period of 10 years. Even after that period, he may be considered for the award of an Oration for a subject entirely unrelated to the one for which he was awarded for an earlier Oration. ***It is recommended that similar rule be incorporated for the Awards as nominations are being made for those who have received an award within the last 3 years. It is proposed that in case of Awards, those who received an Award shall not be re-nominated for a similar or a different Award for a period of at least 5 years; subsequently their nominations may be considered on merit***”.

The details of the Awards and Form for making nominations for the Awards are enclosed.

Nomination(s) are invited for the conferment of Award in the Nomination form enclosed (**eight complete sets with nomination form**) so as to reach the office of the undersigned latest by **16th July, 2018**.

NATIONAL ACADEMY OF MEDICAL SCIENCES (INDIA)
AWARDS 2018

1. **DR. S.S. MISRA MEMORIAL AWARD:** This award was established in 1974 to perpetuate the memory of late Dr. S.S. Misra, a founder Fellow of the Academy. The award is in the form of a bronze Medal and cash prize out of income from endowment, for the best **unpublished** work in any field of Bio-Medical research by a biomedical scientist **below the age of 40 years**.

2. **DR. R.M. KASLIWAL AWARD:** This award was founded by Dr. R.M. Kasliwal, FAMS and is awarded to the best worker in the area of Colon and its Diseases. The candidate is required to submit in addition to details about his work a complete bibliography on the subject including work done in India. There is no age restriction.

3. **DR. VIMLA VIRMANI AWARD:** This award was founded by Dr. Vimla Virmani, FAMS. The award is in the form of a bronze medal and cash prize which is awarded for outstanding work in the field of physical and/or Psychosociological Rehabilitation of Neurologically and/or mentally afflicted subjects based on **published or unpublished** work with particular emphasis on the applicability of the work, under socio-cultural and economic conditions prevalent in the Indian Community.

4. **SHYAM LAL SAKSENA MEMORIAL AWARD:** This award has been established by the family of late Shri Shyam Lal Saxena to perpetuate his memory. The award is in the form of a bronze medal and cash prize out of the income from endowment for the best **unpublished/published** work in the field of Bio-medical Engineering by bio-medical scientists.

5. **DENTAL PUBLIC HEALTH AWARD:** This Award has been established by the Indian Association of Public Health Dentistry with the aim of recognizing merit and encouraging talent in Public Health Dentistry. The award is given for distinguished work carried out by the nominee during the preceding 3 years and **published** in a peer reviewed national or international journal, specifically related to Public Health Dentistry.

6. **DR. S.S. SIDHU AWARD:** This award is instituted in the year 2013 through a donation by Dr. S.S. Sidhu, FAMS for best **published/unpublished** research work in the field of Orthodontics and Maxillofacial Orthopedics by a clinical investigator. The award is in the form of bronze Medal and cash prize out of income from the endowment fund.

7. **DR. VINOD KUMAR BHARGAVA AWARD:** This award is instituted in the year 2013 through a donation by Dr. Vinod Kumar Bhargava, FAMS for best **published/unpublished** research work in the field of Clinical Pharmacology/Drug Development in India by a biomedical scientist **below the age of 45 years**. The award is in the form of bronze Medal and cash prize out of income from the endowment fund.

8. **DR. ARTHUR SARAVANMUTHU THAMBIAH AWARD:** Dr. Arthur Saravanmuthu Thambiah Award is instituted from the year 2014 to recognize the best **published or unpublished** original research work by a biomedical scientist **below the age of 45 years** in Clinical and/or Preventive Dermatology, Medical Mycology, Mycology, Dermatopathology, or any of the basic sciences such as Immunology, Photobiology or Genetics amongst others, related to the speciality of Dermatology. The award is in the form of bronze Medal and cash prize out of income from the endowment funds.
9. **DR. NANDAGUDI SURYANARAYANA RAO AWARD:** This award is instituted in the year 2014 through a donation by Dr. N. Suryanarayana Rao, FAMS. This Award will be given to a Biomedical/Clinical/Public Health Scientist/Biostatistician for significant contributions in the field of Public Health Management/Hospital Administration. The award is in the form of bronze Medal and cash prize out of income from the endowment funds.
10. **DR. J.S. BAJAJ AWARD:** Dr. J.S. Bajaj Award is instituted in the year 2014 to recognize the best research contributions in the field of Medical Education including Bio-medical, Social, Community Health, Nursing, or any other Para-professional **below the age of 45 years** to recognize a research in any subject for all these and related branches. The award is in the form of bronze Medal and cash prize out of income from the endowment funds.
11. **DR. ABHAYA INDRAYAN AWARD:** This award is instituted in the year 2013 through a donation by Dr. Abhaya Indrayan, FAMS for Biomedical/Clinical/Public Health Scientist/ Biostatistician for significant contributions in the field of Clinical Epidemiology, Epidemiology, or Biostatistics as applied to a subject which may have relevance to health sciences. The Award will be given biennially (**once in two years**). The award will be in the form of a Bronze Medal and Cash Prize.
12. **DR. SATYA GUPTA AWARD:** Dr. Satya Gupta Award was instituted in the year 2016 to be given to a candidate, **below the age of 45 years** involved in (**unpublished**) research on Social Pediatrics and the paper should not have been published in any journal before it is presented. The award is in the form of bronze Medal and cash prize out of income from the endowment funds.
13. **DR. TULSI DAS CHUGH:** This award is instituted by Dr. T.D. Chugh, FAMS in the year 2018 for the best published work in the field of Infectious diseases which may include epidemiology, translational studies of pathogenesis, clinical developments of modalities of prevention, control and treatment by a Biomedical Scientist. The award will be in the form of a Bronze Medal and Cash Prize.
